
RECEPTION

- Scanning, copying and printing service




FOYER AND RELAXATION AREA

HISTORICAL ARCHIVES

- M.G.B. Altan Municipal Historical Archives

The public library is home to the archives, which mainly contain documents from the 19th and 20th centuries (up to 1990), although there are some materials dating back to the Napoleonic era and the period preceding it.


All of the materials are systematically organized. On request, they can be consulted for educational purposes and for initiatives to promote documentary heritage.



- It has a video projector, HDMI connections for PCs, speakers and microphones




A taste for knowledge in all its forms
